Clifford L. Dochterman has been appointed to a new position as Assistant to the President of the University of California President Clark Kerr announced yesterday. Dochterman has assumed his new duties, with headquarters in University Hall on the Berkeley campus.

Dochterman has been a frequent visitor to San Diego as Alumni Field Director and Scholarship Director for the California Alumni Association since 1950, according to James W. Archer San Diego attorney who is Vice-President of the California Alumni Association.

"Cliff Dochterman has been one of the most outstanding and effective executive officers the California Alumni Association ever had," Archer said. "We are suffering a great loss, but are proud he has been selected by President Kerr to be one of his major administrative assistants.' It is a just recognition of his talents. We understand he will be working in liaison with the alumni, so that the loss may be alleviated to some extent."

Dochterman will serve as an aide to President Kerr for coordinating numerous student, faculty and community relations for the statewide University.

He has directed alumni club programs throughout the state and nation, and administered the Association's award of 200 scholarships annually.

He graduated from Ohio Wesleyan University in political science in 1947, received a master's degree on the Berkeley campus in 1950, and attended Boalt Hall of Law from 1947 to 1949.

Dochterman is a member of Delta Sigma Rho, Theta Alpha Phi, Pi Sigma Alpha and Omicron Delta Kappa honorary societies. He has been a member of the American Alumni Council Berkeley Rotary Club, Commonwealth Club, and Board of Directors of the Wesley Foundation and Trinity Methodist Church.

No successor has been named to assume his duties with the California Alumni Association
