Points of Interest on the Way to San Diego

ORANGE GROVES

Five million boxes of oranges and about \$1,500,000 worth of lemons were produced in this section last year.

SUGAR BEETS

75,000 acres which yield 150,000,000 pounds of sugar are found in Orange County.

OIL FIELDS

The wells dotting the foot-hills to the left of the boulevard produced \$40,000,000 worth of oil last year.

SANTA ANA

The capital of Orange County and the principal city of this section, headquarters for citrus, farming and oil industries of the surrounding section.

SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO MISSION

Built in 1776 by Father Junipero Serra. Destroyed in 1812. The stages make a half-hour stop while passengers peruse the ruins and drop in at the Palm Cafe for lunch.

TORREY PINES

A species of pines peculiar to this one spot, found no place else in the world.

U. S. BIOLOGICAL STATION

Pacific Coast, headquarters for Government Marine Research work.

LA JOLLA

Famous for its caves which can be seen at the foot of the cliffs upon leaving the Biological Station. These are noted for their beautiful coloring and massive structure. The most famous caverns are the White Lady and Sunny Jim caves.

OLD TOWN

The first Spanish settlement in California. The cross on the hillside to the left of the road is made from the tiles of original chapel, founded by the Franciscan Fathers. The stately palm is the first tree planted in California.

RAMONA'S MARRIAGE PLACE

The old house which was occupied by the Estudillo family has been immortalized by Helen Hunt Jackson as the marriage place of Ramona.
