

UCSD to hold six-week summer session

May 21, 1979

The University of California, San Diego will hold a six-week summer session beginning July 9 and ending August 17.

Summer session will offer a wide variety of courses open to students presently enrolled in any University of California campus, students at any other college or university, high school graduates "who have the maturity and aptitude for the level of study required," and students who will be high school seniors in the fall of 1979 and may wish to get an early start on their college careers.

Courses will be offered in a number of different departments including anthropology, biology, chemistry, history, language, literature, mathematics, physical education, psychology and sociology.

Registration for summer session is presently under way with students encouraged to register in advance by mail.
