(1) POWELL RIVER TOWNSHIP


The establishment of a Rural Police Post at Taitavua has been approved by the police and the local people have set aside 5 acres for this purpose.

(2) WANG COUNCIL

The Wang Council is at present drawing up a five year development plan which will include the location of future schools. The matter of obtaining suitable land should be decided and finally settled before the plan receives the approval of the council and submissions are made to the District Education Board. The Council will be advised in this respect at the next meeting.

The patrol conducted by Mr. Brown was beneficial in providing better communication between the people and the Council. Points raised, should be given serious consideration when the council five year plan is drawn up.

As you mention in your patrol instructions the matter of purchase  
of the WABAG/CHIEF DIVISION road has been entrusted and the local  
inhabitants are becoming understandably restless. Delay has been  
caused in part by repeated staff changes and delay in receipt of the plan  
of the center line of the Highway. The project now requires some  
priority of attention so that it can be finalized and done with once  
and for all.

Although not mentioned by Mr. MURPHY in his report, it is believed  
that his patrol had use of a new rest house recently built by the  
WABAG/CHIEF DIVISION people with the encouragement of Juncillor IKIPAI. These  
people have hitherto been considered to be troublemakers but they now  
appear to be making attempts at accommodation with field staff. This  
is good and should be constructively followed up by us.

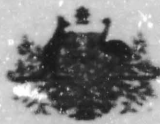

INTRODUCTION

The necessary action was taken to conduct this patrol when a tribal fight broke out between groups (see Situation Report No. 1) in the Upper Lai Commis Division. The fight broke out on Monday the 14th of October. At the 15th of October, vast numbers of allied tribesmen arrived into the fight area from Lake Iseba and the Acher Valley to give support to the ACHER and LAHAI Clans who were the main combatants involved.

The pattern of fighting that took place and the subsequent action taken by police is outlined in the attached Situation Report.

INVOLVEMENT OF C.A. & D.A. OFFICERS IN THE CONFLICT AND POLICE ACTION.

When efforts to mediate between the combatants failed and officers were attacked, in strength by the ACHER/ACHER and their allies, all C.A. & D.A. officers retreated from the immediate fight area. Photos were taken of the combatants by the A.D.C. Leisner who used his personal photographic equipment. Other officers in the area, attempted, with the aid of interpreters to identify and list the names and social groupings of combatants. At no time during the fight was any attempt made to prevent the fighting. Your gun was not available until after hostilities had ceased.

Immediately the fighting stopped, C.A. & D.A. Officers were attached to police patrols which visited all local hamlets. Some people who had been wounded in the fight, were arrested.

From KONGIRAN, camps manned with police, interpreters and C.A. and D.A. Officers were established at strategic points in the vicinity of Imbataria, Lake Iseba plus CHOCAN and LAHAI in the Acher Valley. Night and day raids were made on hamlets from these camps and further combatants were arrested. All those involved in the fight were unable to re occupy their home areas and were denied the use of their gardens and houses.

Many of the people involved, moved into LAHAI and KONGIRAN in the Acher Valley. A patrol made up of the A.D.C. Sebo, one Patrol Officer and one Trainee Patrol Officer plus half of a mobile armed patrolled along the Acher Valley and further arrests were made.

#### NATIVE AFFAIRS

One of the most outstanding aspects of the MOREIMAN fight, was the speed with which allied clans gathered from over a widespread area to assist in the fight.

Throughout the fight, those involved showed utter contempt for the C.M. & D.A. officers and police present.

When the warriors opened fire on the A.D.C. Sabag, fighting was not in progress and there still appeared a chance that the matter could be settled by arbitration. The initial shots were fired by young men of allied groups who had walked over from MONGGAN. The man who led the attack against the A.D.C. has since been arrested and sentenced to one year imprisonment with hard labour in the District Court, Sabag.

Throughout, every effort was made to arrest all those involved including those from allied groups. The police patrols over a widespread area had considerable effect on the local population.

Compensation negotiations between the lines involved will commence when all those at present in prison are discharged.

#### ANDATALE BASE CAMP

At each centre visited in the Anson Valley, repeated requests were made for the construction of a Base Camp located central to the population in this area.

From the survey conducted by the patrol, ANDATALE appears to be the most suitable location. The people at Andatale have marked out an area of approximately 10 acres of suitable land for this purpose. The only other suitable area was at MONGGAN. However, suitable land for a Base Camp was not available in close proximity to the existing road. It is therefore recommended that a Base Camp be established at ANDATALE as soon as staff become available.






