(1) POLICE STATION TRANSMISSION


The establishment of a Rural Police Post at Tschobis has been approved by the police and people have set aside 5 acres for this.

(2) NEWLY DRAWN

The Naga Council is at present drawing up a five year development plan which will include the location of future schools. The matter of obtaining suitable land should be decided and firmly settled before the plan receives the approval of the council and submissions are made to the District Education Board. The Council will be advised in this respect at the next meeting.

The patrol conducted by Mr. Dunn was beneficial in providing better communication between the people and the Council. Points raised, should be given serious consideration when the council five year plan is drawn up.



Duty has been given to the concerned staff members and delay in receipt of the plan and drawings of the Surveyor. The project now requires some further information so that it can be finalised and done with ease and speed.

Although not mentioned by Mr. MISHRA in his report, it is believed that the person had one of a new rest house recently built by the Government people with the encouragement of Councillor KIPAL. These people have hitherto been considered to be troublemakers but they now appear to be making attempts at accommodation with field staff. This is good and should be encouragingly followed up by us.



INCIDENT

The necessary action was taken by command this patrol when a tribal fight broke out between groups (see Situation Report No.1) in the Lower Lae Census Division. The fight broke out on Sunday the 14th of October, at the 15th of October, first rounds of allied tribesmen moved into the fight area from Lake Iwisa and the Lower Valley to give support to the ANGUL and LAGUL Clans who were the main contestants involved.

The pattern of fighting that took place and the subsequent action taken by police is outlined in the attached Situation Report.

INVESTIGATION OF THE INCIDENT BY POLICE AND ARMY OFFICERS

When efforts to arbitrate between the contestants failed and officers were attacked, in strength by the SHANG/SHANGA and their allies, all C.O. & S.A. officers retreated from the immediate fight area. Photos were taken of the contestants by the A.D.C. Images who used his personal photographic equipment. Other officers in the area, attempted, with the aid of interpreters to identify and list the names and social groupings of contestants. At no time during the fight was any attempt made to prevent the fighting. That was not possible until after hostilities had ceased.

Immediately the fighting stopped, C.O. & S.A. officers were attached to police patrols which visited all local houses. Some people who had been wounded in the fight, were arrested.

From KONGIWA, camps manned with police, interpreters and C.O. and S.A. Officers were established at strategic points in the vicinity of Tschutavua, Lake Iwisa plus SHANG and LAGUL in the Lower Valley. Night and day raids were made on houses near these camps and further contestants were arrested. All those involved in the fight were unable to re occupy their home areas and were denied the use of their gardens and houses.

Navy of six people involved, moved into LAGUL and SHANG in the Lower Valley. A patrol made up of the A.D.C. Subay, one Patrol Officer and one Trainee Patrol Officer plus half of a canine squad patrolled along the Lower Valley and further arrests were made.

NATIVE AFFAIRS

One of the most outstanding aspects of the KURELAW fight, was the speed with which allied clans gathered from over a widespread area to assist in the fight.

Throughout the fight, those involved showed utter contempt for the C.I.C. & D.A. officers and police present.

When the warriors opened fire on the A.G.C. camp, fighting was not in progress and there still appeared a chance that the matter could be settled by arbitration. The initial shots were fired by young men of allied groups who had walked over from MENGALA. The man who led the attack against the A.G.C. has since been arrested and sentenced to one year imprisonment with hard labour in the District Court, Sabag.

Throughout, every effort was made to arrest all those involved including those from allied groups. The police patrols over a widespread area had considerable effect on the local population.

Compensation negotiations between the lines involved will commence when all those at present in prison are discharged.

ANDATELE BASE CAMP

At each centre visited in the Axum Valley, repeated requests were made for the construction of a Base Camp located central to the population in this area.

From the survey conducted by the patrol, ANDATELE appears to be the most suitable location. The people at Andatele have marked out an area of approximately 10 acres of suitable land for this purpose. The only other suitable area was at MENGALA. However, suitable land for a Base Camp was not available in close proximity to the existing road. It is therefore recommended that a Base Camp be established at ANDATELE as soon as staff become available.
