

Friends of the Library book sale will take place May 3-4

April 22, 1975

The third annual book sale, sponsored by the Friends of the UCSD Library, will take place Saturday and Sunday, May 3 and 4, on the entrance walk of the Central University Library at the University of California, San Diego.

Over 8,000 books will be available during the two-day sale scheduled from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day. Included will be many unusual scholarly publications on a wide range of subjects, books in foreign languages, and an interesting group of 19th-century medical books and other "quaint" publications of the period. There will also be some musical recordings.

Prices range from 10 cents to a few dollars with most items selling at 50 cents or less.

The majority of the items to be sold were collected by the Friends for the event. Proceeds from the sale will be used by the Friends to purchase special books and materials needed for various library collections.

The Friends is made up of 1,200 community members, UCSD faculty and staff and others who support the University Library through the building of special collections and by raising funds to support its growth. Over the years, the Friends have been instrumental in helping build such special collections as those dealing with Baja California, the desert and oceanography.
