The map accompanying the report could have been made more informative by the inclusion of the approximate location of overnight camps, helicopter pad and possible Mission sirstrip site, all mentioned in the Report.

As it was necessary to mention shotgum to population figures the apparent abundance or scarcity of wild game would have been of interest.

Fidgin Melanesian words should be properly spalt, using quotation marks when used in English text. "Tulip" and "Apile" have recognised comes mass spelings.

The arduous nature of patrolling in sparsely populated mountainous terrain is appropiated. Your advice that Mr. Winfield adequately performed the task set out is noted.



- 1. One very surprising thing or matter I found out here was that there was no encouragement of agricultural products in this area, because no agriculture Officer has been permanently posted. Until recently this year and agriculture Officer was sent since this station was set up.
- 2. Actually vegetables grow better in here, people grow vegetables such as cabbages, cabages grow better in here at the place, and also they grow onions, lettuce, pituit, corm, passaw, but there is no proper market to sell as Telefonia market is very small in other words the supply is great, but the demand is small.
- 3. In some places I found cut that the people do plant coffee very well, but as I said, lack of encouragement, people lost interest in growing vegetables and other cash crops like coffee.
- 4. To my point of view I think that an Agricultural Officer or any of his assistants should be sent out toevery village and find out better places to grow crops and also encourage them to grow more coffee. Not just stay in the station and say that the ground in Telefomin is not good for plenting anything. If this is done before hand I hope that these people would have a better living like any other place in this country of PMG, when growing cash crops and get the benefit out of it for their hard work.

- 1. No epidemic type of sickness was found during my staying in the area, only minor infections like tropical ulcer (sore) dyrhea, mumps and cough was noted with no case, but said sickness were noticed by me and I sent the persons to Telefomin Rospital to get treatment daily.
- Only one death was occurred when a lady age about 25 from Konduwip village, which is half a days welk from Telefomin.
   She died when she was in a hard labour, delivering the baby.
- 3. Generally, according to over-all health of the people, it is actually 90% healthy, as there is Council Aid Fosts in some Council ir Wards that provides better services for all the people in the Council Area. Besides that, when the person is seriously ill or wounded, he is then, sent to either Government Rospital or the Baptist Mission Mospital in Telefomin station, for treatment.
