

Art Disposal Service

On Monday evenings, beginning November 4, Art Disposal Service dump trucks will make the first of their monthly fiveminute stops in front of each gallery on La Cienega Boulevard. Gallery dealers are invited to take advantage of this service by selecting unwanted works of art and placing them on the sidewalk to be picked up by A. D. S. volunteers. The work will then be taken to the Los Angeles city dump and disposed of.

The Art Disposal Service is non-profit, and staffed by volunteers as a public service. Its sole purpose is to eliminate bad art.

Expanded service in the near future will include monthly stops at museums, art centers, collectors' homes, etc.
