MEDIA ADVISORY

EVENT: Press conference to announce the San Diego premiere of "Peace Child," a children's musical play about bringing peace to the world. The production involves young performers from the United States (16), the Soviet Union (15) and Australia (1), who will perform briefly at the news conference.

DATE: July 22, 1988

TIME: 9:30 a.m.

LOCATION: Room 111A, Matthews Academic and Administrative Complex. (See map)

REMARKS: "Peace Child" is a play with music telling how children bring peace to the world in 2025 after persuading world leaders to end aggression. The play's narrator will be Anna Strasberg, who was married to the late Lee Strasberg, who led the prestigious Actors Studio in New York City. Strasberg will be attending the press conference.

Peace Child Foundation volunteers Howard and Barbara Katz, of La Jolla, will be present to facilitate a question and answer session with Strasberg and members of the cast.

Every "Peace Child" play and its songs are composed by the cast members, with one element remaining the same: world peace by 2025. The group, which will perform in San Diego, will also play in Ojai, Santa Barbara, Los Angeles and Irvine.
