UCSD PRESENTS THE PEABODY TRIO -- APRIL 3

The Peabody Trio, winners of the 1989 Naumburg Chamber Music Award, will perform at 8 p.m. Saturday, April 3, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

Tickets for this event are \$18 for general admission, and may be purchased at the UCSD Price Center Box Office or from TicketMaster outlets.

The members of the trio are Violaine Melancon, violin; Bonnie Thron, cello and Seth Knopp, piano. The program will be Mozart: Piano Trio in B-flat Major, KV 502; Copeland: Vitebsk, and Brahms: Piano Trio in C Major, Op. 87.

The Peabody Trio was formed in 1986 in San Francisco. The next year they began a full-time residency at the Peabody Conservatory of Music in Baltimore, MD. In 1988, the trio was awarded a first prize in the Baltimore Chamber Music Awards Competition. In the summers of 1987 and 1988, the ensemble was one of two resident ensembles at the Tanglewood Music Center in Massachusetts. They gave their New York City debut at the Alice Tully Hall, Lincoln Center, in April 1990.

The ensemble commissions and performs new music, as well as performing standard trio literature. Because of a paucity of music written for trios, the Peabody Trio, with the Peabody Conservatory, have established a program for commissioning new works.
