Paul E. Mares, manager of the University of California, San Diego Bookstore, recently served as Dean of the 26th annual National Association of College Stores (NACS) Management Seminar at Stanford University.

Some 90 college store personnel from the Western United States, including three from UCSD, attended the program which was held July 22-28.

The seminar, one of two held each summer by NACS, featured first and second-year classwork and also included a management survey course for individuals new to the college store field.

Mares has also served as chairman of the NACS Education Committee and was dean last year of the NACS seminar held at Oberlin College in Oberlin, Ohio, NACS headquarters.
