My indebtedness to James Stark and Sarah Stark his wife for money borrowed July 26th 1854. for \$25000. secured by Mortgage dated July 26. 1854. drawing interest at the rate of 2 1/2 per cent: month upon the following described property.

One fourth interest in Court Block in San Francisco - Also my right: title & interest in the tract of land known as South San Francisco, Also property known as "Mayfield" farm situated in Santa Clara County and twenty four 50 vara lots in the City of San Jose together with improvements, reference being had to said mortgage for a more particular description of said property.

And said indebtedness is further secured by a Mortgage dated February 26. 1855. on the following described property certain Lots in the City of San Jose. Also my right: title and interest in the Rancho Los Colusi and in the Rancho Willy both then situated in Butte County, and my right: title and interest in the Rancho of the River San Joaquin then being in Mariposa County reference being had for a more particular description of said property to the Mortgage last above mentioned.

Judgment on Foreclosure in the 3^d Judicial District of the State of California and sale effected

thereon reference being had to the proceedings in said cause.

Judgment in the Fourth District Court of San Francisco in favor J. B. Bayeque in place of S. Crofs Dew. deceased obtained May 3rd 1856 for \$16,715.75

Costs 59.95

bearing interest at the rate of 3% per month obtained upon Foreclosure of Mortgage and Note dated March 3rd 1854 for \$10,000. being the first mortgage upon the property known as Court Block situated on Clay street and Merchant in the City of San Francisco reference being had to said Note and Mortgage and Judgment for a more particular description of said property and indebtedness.

My Note jointly with S. F. Elliott for \$3000 - dated March 3rd 1854. Secured by Mortgage of even date of my right title and interest in the property known as South San Francisco, upon which foreclosure has been had and Judgment obtained thereupon in the 4th District Court of San Francisco on the 22 day of September 1856 for \$3376.⁶⁵/₁₀₀ + \$51.²⁵/₁₀₀ + Sale effected upon said mortgaged property.

Judgment in the 3rd judicial District Court of the State of California obtained about the 1st day of November AD 1856. wherein Moses Schelenberger is plaintiff and Insolvent is defendant obtained upon a Note dated Dec 11. 1854 for \$500. bearing interest at the rate of 3% per month given in settlement

of a reference being had to the proceedings in said cause.

My guarantee and covenant contained in Deed to S. B. Hensley dated about September 1854 on sale of certain property at San Jose known as Homestead containing 24-50 Vara Lots,

My note favor of S. F. Elliott dated April 14, 1854 for \$8666.66 given on contract to purchase $\frac{1}{2}$ interest in Court-Block, situated in San Francisco, The said Note being payable upon the contingency of said interest in Court-Block being conveyed to Insolvent-free and clear of incumbrance on or before the first-day of May 1855 of which said conveyance having been made the consideration of said Note has entirely failed - The said Note is now claimed to be held by Bouchard upon which suit has been instituted in the - Court and which is now pending, reference being had to the proceedings therein for more particularity. Note dated and time unknown to Joseph Gordon for \$1000 -

My note date and time unknown in favor of Mrs Sarah Green now Mrs Joseph F. Wallis for about \$1200 - for borrowed money.

Judgment in the Justices Court of the 2nd Township San Francisco County obtained July 31st 1855, in favor of W. S. Booker for balance due for Insurance on Court-Block \$122.50.

Debt due Adams & Co about \$1311. for borrowed money date unknown. -
