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## **Rady School of Management at UC San Diego Hosts Summer Institute for Emerging Managers and Leaders**

The Rady School of Management at UC San Diego will host the 2015 Summer Institute for Emerging Managers and Leaders (SIEML) August 2 to August 14, 2015. The Summer Institute is an all-expenses-paid, career-building fellowship for 25, first-year students from historically black colleges and universities and Hispanic-serving institutions across the U.S. The program is in part made possible by the partnership of corporate sponsors.

Summer Institute fellows will participate in an intensive two-week program, offered for two successive summers and designed to expose them to valuable educational and career-building opportunities.
