

Chairman of the department of Earth Sciences for SSE has been selected

President Clark Kerr of The University of California announced today in Berkeley that Edward D. Goldberg, Associate Professor of Chemistry at The University's Scripps Institution of Oceanography, has been selected as Chairman of the Department of Earth Sciences for The University's School of Science and Engineering at La Jolla.

Goldberg is the first departmental chairman to be named for the new graduate school. A native of Sacramento, he received his B.S. from the University of California, Berkeley, his Ph.D., in Chemistry, from the University of Chicago. He has been a member of the Scripps staff since 1949.

The first candidates for advanced degrees in the earth sciences will be accepted for enrollment in the fall term, 1960.
