

Dr. Stanford S. Penner named winner of 1979 Numa Manson Medal

Dr. Stanford S. Penner, professor of engineering physics and director of the University of California, San Diego Energy Center, has been named winner of the 1979 Numa Manson Medal presented at the 7th International Colloquium on Gasdynamics of Explosions and Reactive Systems in Gottingen, Germany, in August.

The award cited Penner's pioneering studies on liquid and solid rockets, combustion science and radiation gasdynamics as well as his recent contributions to the development of new fossil-fuel energy technologies. The award has been presented biannually since 1975.

Penner is a member of the National Academy of Engineering and the international Academy of Astronautics and a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
