

Grad student Warren Burt presents electronic music program

New electronic music will be presented in a tape concert organized by University of California, San Diego Graduate student Warren Burt at 8:30 p.m., Tuesday, April 18.

Sponsored by the UCSD department of music, the concert will be held in the Recital Hall, Bldg. 409, on the Matthews Campus, and is free and open to the public.

Works to be played will include "Tangential Energy II," a tape of a live performance given at UC Davis in 1963 by UCSD graduate student John Mizelle; a work by Ernie Morgan composed at Mills College Electronic Music Studio (Oakland) in 1971, and UCSD graduate student Alan Merian's "Liquid Joyce" written as music for Company Theater at UCSD in 1971. A new work by UCSD graduate student David Gamper will also be played.
