## Librarian appointed for the La Jolla campus

Melvin J. Voigt, Director of the Library and Professor of Librarianship at Kansas State University, has accepted appointment as Librarian of the La Jolla campus of The University of California, Roger Revelle, Director, announced this week.

Mr. Voigt's appointment will commence on November 1, 1960. He will have general supervision over all libraries of The University of California, La Jolla, including the library of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography. This library has been built up during the past fifty years in oceanography, but it is inadequate for the fields of study and research embraced by the new graduate School of Science and Engineering. Consequently, Mr. Voigt's first major task will be to build up the library of the new School. W. Roy Holleman will continue as Scripps Institution Librarian under Mr. Voigt's over-all direction.

A native of California, Mr. Voigt received bachelor's and master's degrees in library science from the University of Michigan. He has worked in libraries at Michigan, General Mills, Carnegie Institute of Technology, and The University of California, Berkeley, and has written a book and numerous articles in the field of library science. He is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the Special Libraries Association, the American Chemical Society, and Phi Kappa Phi. During the 1958-59 academic year, he was a Fulbright Research Fellow at the University of Copenhagen, Denmark.
