

## **Computer Jobs Through Training program recruiting**

Computer Jobs Through Training, a training program based at the University of California, San Diego, is holding a series of 11 student recruitment open house sessions designed to recruit students for a computer programming class scheduled to begin in San Diego in January.

A second series of open houses to recruit students for a class in the San Ysidro area will begin after the first of the year.

The training, for San Diego area disadvantaged young adults, is offered in a 40-foot mobile classroom which carries the necessary computer hardware and classroom facilities directly to the students' own community.

Interested students can apply for training in this free program by attending one of the afternoon open house sessions in the computer van. Open houses will be held at MAAC project, 827 A Avenue, National City on the afternoons of December 16, 17 and 22, and at the San Diego Skills Center on 13th Street between E and F in downtown San Diego on the afternoons of December 18, 19, 21 and 23 and January 4, 5, 8 and 9.
