

It has saddened all of us in the Metro Region that one of our own chapters has violated the decision made on the State level, but, as I stated in the letter, it is not only an injustice to the MAPA membership statewide, but it also lends credibility to any future MAPA endorsements.

Since this occurred on the Metro Region level, we felt that it should be taken up by the Metro Region Executive Board before being referred to the State. Our decision was made unanimously and I believe the letter to Mr. Macias is self-explanatory.

Please advise when the next State Executive Board meeting will be held, so that a decision may be passed down by the State. May I also remind you that it was voted upon at our last State Executive Board meeting that the next State Executive Board meeting would be held in the Southern Region.

There are many important issues presently at hand in the Metro Region, such as the Mayor's race, etc. It is therefore quite important that this matter be cleared up as soon as possible.

For all intents and purposes we are a State Chartered organization and we should all work together. We in the Metro Region are only enforcing that decision handed down by you at our State Convention.

Dear Jesse:

It has been brought to the attention of the Metro Region Executive Board that on November 2, 1972, an ad was placed in the Kovner Publications by MAPA 40th A.D. that clearly states a MAPA Endorsement for Senator George McGovern.

As you are very well aware, at our State Endorsing Convention which took place on October 14 and 15, 1972, State MAPA came out with a "no endorsement", or in essence a "no action taken" position on the Presidential race. There was some discussion as to whether a chapter could endorse autonomously, and it was at this time that our State President, Mr. Armando Rodriquez, emphatically stated that a position had been taken on the State level and any chapter who violated this position would have their Chapter Charter revoked. This was written into the minutes which were taken by Mrs. Lyn Durocher.

Our state position was very well publicized by the media, and any individual or chapter who violates this position is not only rendering an injustice to the membership statewide, but, has also lent credibility to any future MAPA endorsements.

At our last Metro Region Executive Board meeting, it was decided and voted upon unanimously by the Board that due to MAPA 40th A.D.'s violation of the state rendered position, as of this date, January 8, 1973, MAPA 40th is temporarily suspended as a chapter, until such time as the State Executive Board can render a decision.

In short, the MAPA 40th A.D. Chapter is barred from using the name "MAPA 40th A.D.", any meetings, functions, publications, etc., will henceforth be considered illegal.

Since MAPA 40th is a Metro Region Chapter, the decision was made by the Metro Region Executive Board. We are now referring it to the State, and any questions pertaining to this suspension must be taken up at a State Executive Board meeting.

Dear Toni:

This letter is to inform you that at our recent MAPA Southern Region membership meeting held in Banning California on February 11, 1973, we wholeheartedly supported your efforts against MAPA 40th for its arbitrary endorsement of Senator McGovern after the MAPA state position of no endorsement had been clearly articulated to the general public.

This action is but symbolic of the organizational decay that statewide MAPA is experiencing because adequate leadership is not being provided by our statewide officers. This organizational decay is best symbolized by one of our state vice presidents who was instructed not to publically endorse because it would dilute the whole idea of having a state endorsing convention. Nevertheless, this individual arbitrarily sought to disregard the wishes of the various regions representatives present at that particular state executive board meeting held in Los Angeles and openly endorsed before and after the state position of no endorsement was made known to the general public.

In view of this attitude of disregard that seems to be common to our state officers, we must re-examine the accountability factor of our state officers, so that we either progress politically as a statewide unit or else we send MAPA to the junk pile of history where all the other organizations that base their efforts on rhetoric and not concrete results belong.

We will not allow any state officer to flaunt his delegated authority so that he can feel big in the eyes of a senator who means our people no earthly good. There are too many vital issues facing our communities (Raza Unida, Rodino Bill) for us to rely on state officers who are too busy building their own little nest eggs. The Southern Region will no longer waste its efforts on state officers who have become organizational dead wood.

We urge you to continue your efforts to make our state officers more responsive to the needs of Chicanos in California and also more responsive to the current political thought (Raza Unida) that is developing in Chicano communities throughout the Southwest.

Bareno named liaison officer for Walsh

Supervisor Jack Walsh has named a National City man, Augie Bareno, 25, as community liaison for the first supervisorial district.



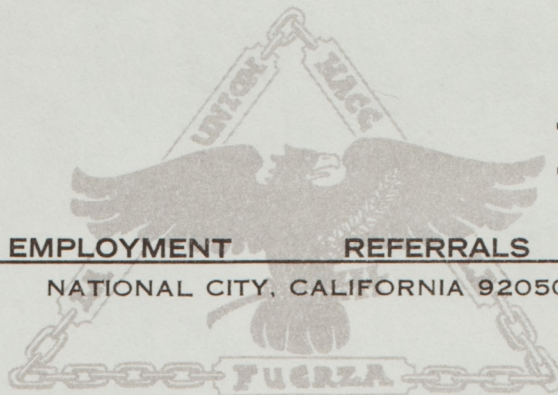
