HEREAS you have this Day received Orders for inlifting 56 Soldiers, including Serjeants, for the Massachusetts Service, for the Preservation of the Liberties of America: You are hereby acquainted that the Commission of a Captain in said Service shall be made out for you as soon as you have compleated the said Inlistment, and you will also be allowed to nominate 2 Subalterns to serve under you, who will receive Commissions accordingly, if the Committee shall approve of them.
