

They design and build their own instruments, utilizing diverse contemporary materials from a wide variety of sources. With these instruments they create a unique aural and visual world in a spontaneous and collective music.

The instruments capture the unique characteristics of materials from today's technological and industrial environment. These materials are chosen for their outstanding acoustic properties. The instruments are fabricated from ceramics, rare and exotic metal alloys, electronic components, wood, rubber, and plastics. Their design incorporates the visual dimension as well. The instruments are true Sound Sculptures.



With full display of light, shape, movement and sound, CONFLUENCE performs concerts in a number of settings including universities, museums, dance studios and art galleries.

CONFLUENCE also designs instruments and sound installations to interact with architectural and natural environments.


Workshops in musical instrument design and sound sculpture may be given alone or in combination with lectures, concerts, and exhibitions.
