Members of the "X Revolution Quartet" are Lenon Honor, flute; Levon Obee, piano; Keith Ellington Mingus, bass viol and Peter Gonzales III, drums.

"Means Purpose" members are Vernon Tucker, guitar; Daryl Williams, upright bass and Craig Dawson, drums.

Members of the "Peter Gonzales III Quintet" are Thomas Alfoque, trumpet; Berk McKelvey, tenor saxophone and bass clarinet; Oliver Shorley, bass; Eric Griswold, piano and Peter Gonzales III, drums and tympani.

The "Mungus" ensemble is Eric Lindburg, tenor sax; Eric Griswold, piano; Oliver Shirley, bass and Brett Sanders, drums. This combo performs. all-original compositions.

Members of the "Quartette plus 1," are Martin Chandler, bass; Mark Applebaum, leader and piano; Brett Sanders and Craig Dawson, percussion and Ed Felix, saxophone.

The UCSD Jazz Orchestra and UCSD Jazz Combos also will perform at 8 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 10, for the KSDS-FM (Jazz 88.3) "Jazz Live" concert at the San Diego City College Auditorium. This concert is free and open to the public.
