

## **Second Annual College and University Information Fair**

Recruiters representing nearly 60 universities and colleges from throughout California are scheduled to take part in the second annual College and University Information Fair Tuesday, October 25, at the University of California, San Diego.

The fair, the only one of its kind to be held in the San Diego area, is open to all prospective college students interested in public and private California colleges and universities. The academic recruiters will be on hand to answer questions and to provide information about special educational opportunities, financial aid, and academic programs at the various universities and colleges.

In addition, Air Force and Army ROTC information will also be available.

The fair is scheduled from 7 to 9 p.m. in the Recreation Gym at UCSD which is located directly south of the Main Gym in the center of the campus.

According to William G. Stiles Jr., senior student affairs officer at UCSD, the fair will be one of the largest college fairs ever held in this area. He said the fair will be well worth the time for anyone thinking of entering college within the next year.

"Comprehensive, up-to-date information available to participants can help them make better choices of schools and programs in which to apply," Stiles said.
