## Places of Interest in the Vicinity of the Hotel.

The glass enclosed hot salt water plunge baths.
The Museum, containing 10,000 interesting specimens. The finest collection west of Philadelphta.
Curio Bazaar-Interesting exhibit of curiosities from Artzona, New and Old Mexico, and the Pacifle coast.
The Company's Botanical Gardens, on Third Street and D Avenue.
A Trip on the Motor Line around the Bay to San Dlego, and return by the electric car and ferry system, makes a pleasant change.

The Ostrich Farm, corner of Tenth Street and B Avenue. Many Ostriches and Australian Emus; odd and interestfing to look at.
