

Phyllis Curtin will sing a program of classical and modern music at a recital in La Jolla, April 8

Metropolitan Opera star Phyllis Curtin will sing a program of classical and modern music at a recital in La Jolla at 8:30 p.m., Sunday, April 8.

The famous soprano will appear under the auspices of the University of California's All-University Concert Series at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla.

Tickets for the event are \$1.00 for students, \$2.50 general admission. The \$1.00 student rates applies to all elementary, high school, and college students.

Widely acclaimed for her operatic triumphs in this country and abroad, Miss Curtin will be heard in songs by Handel, Mozart and others. On the program are four of Samuel Barber's "Hermit Songs." The texts of these are genuine mediaeval lyrics, written by Irish monks.

The All-University Concerts are presented under terms of a recent private endowment to the University which sponsors programs of lectures and concerts in the University communities.
