NOTES: UC San Diego will christen its new \$4,000 four-oared racing shell the N.D. "McElroy" in honor of UCSD Chancellor William McElroy. UC San Diego has about 40 students participating in rowing but has had to borrow a four-oared shell until the chancellor allocated money to purchase this boat.

The UC San Diego crews, under the direction of Coach Jack Vallerga, will participate in a row-by at 10 a.m. The dedication ceremony will follow at 10:15 a.m. with acceptance by Chancellor McElroy and talks by Greg Baker, chairman of the UCSD Rowing Club; Bonnie Sullivan, a member of the UCSD crew, and Judy Sweet, UC San Diego athletic director. A brunch will follow at 10:30 a.m. Visitors will be given a chance to row in the training barge following the ceremony.
