RANGAN NAMED ACTING MANAGING EDITOR FOR MULTIMEDIA SYSTEMS

P. Vankat Rangan, assistant professor of computer science and engineering at the University of California, San Diego has been named acting managing editor of Multimedia Systems, the first international scholarly journal devoted to multimedia systems, technology and applications.

The publication, scheduled to be launched this spring by Springer-Verlag of The Netherlands, is expected to focus on original research articles dealing with state-of-the-art methods and tools in all aspects of multimedia computing, communication, storage, and applications among researchers, engineers and practitioners.

Rangan, who directs research in UCSD's Multimedia Laboratory, also will serve as program chair for ACM Multimedia 93, the first ACM international conference on multimedia. The conference, scheduled August 2-6 in Anaheim, Calif., will coincide with SIGGRAPH 93. ACM Multimedia 93 is designed to provide an international forum for papers, panels, courses, workshops, and exhibits "focusing on the synergies between processing and communicating information represented in multiple media (multimedia)."
