

Angela Davis to lecture

Angela Davis, a leading activist during the student turmoils of the late 1960s, will give a public lecture at 5 p.m. Friday, Jan. 18, in room 2722 of the Undergraduate Sciences Building on the Revelle campus at the University of California, San Diego.

Davis is scheduled to speak on "Third World People in Higher Education." Her visit to UC San Diego is sponsored by the Student Affirmative Action Committee.

Davis, 36, now teaches at San Francisco State University. She is co-chairperson of the National Alliance Against Racism and Political Repression and she is running as vice president on the Communist Party's 1980 presidential ticket.
