The University of California, San Diego Student Outreach and Recruitment Office will host an informational meeting on the Early Admissions Honors Program on Feb. 24, 1988 at 6:30 p.m. in Peterson Hall, Room 110, Third College.

The Early Admission Honors Program provides an opportunity for qualified students to enroll at UCSD concurrently in their last year of high school. Qualifications for the program include a 4.0 GPA and the completion of all but 4.5 units of the University of California admission requirements.

Students are formally admitted to the university and may take one or two courses each quarter for full college credit. Their access to academic advising, use of the libraries and other academic privileges are the same as those of all UCSD students.
