





My dear Mrs. Tuley:

I was not aware that your water had been shut off: in fact, I don't have time to attend to the details of the company, but I have a report from Mr. Mathews, as follows:

That on April 14, you paid \$3.75 for water for January, February and March,

That on January 12, you paid \$2.50 for May and June, according to your records,

That on July 8, you paid \$1.25 for the July rent.

This leaves \$1.25 due for the month of April

I want you to feel free at any time to write me in relation to these matters. Kindly let me hear from you in this matter. If you have any receipts for April water, you can rest assured that we shall be very flad to correct the error, but this is according to our records.
