L'UPIC, the French computer that allows the user to compose music by drawing a picture, will be demonstrated in a concert at 8 p.m. on October 19, at the University of California, San Diego Center for Music Experiment.

Francois-Bernard Mache, president of Les Ateliers Upic, and Alain Despres, director, will perform the music they have graphically composed. The music of L'UPIC's originator, composer lannis Xanakis, will also be performed.

The concert is free and open to the public.

There will be a L'UPIC demonstration for high school students at 7 p.m. Wednesday, October 12, in the University of California, San Diego's Center for Music Experiment. San Diego high school students are invited. The demonstration is free and open to the general public. L'UPIC is a French computer which allows the user to compose music by drawing a picture. The greater knowledge the user has of music--crescendo, decrescendo and the spatial relationship between musical notation and the musical stave--the more sophisticated will be the resulting musical composition.
