

Media alert, British percussion group STOMP to perform at Spreckels Theater in downtown San Diego

EVENT: An added performance on Feb. 11 for British percussion group STOMP, scheduled to perform Feb. 9 and 10 at 8 p.m. and Feb. 11 at 3 p.m. at Spreckels Theater.

DATE/TIME: The additional performance will be at 8 p.m. Feb. 11.

LOCATION: Spreckels Theater in downtown San Diego.

BACKGROUND: STOMP is an award-winning group that uses common objects -- garbage cans, brooms, wooden poles, hubcaps, lighters, even the kitchen sink -- to create uncommon sounds. They bang, slap, knock, tap, drum, whatever, to create their innovative din. They've appeared on The Kennedy Center Honors, The Late Show with David Letterman, The Tonight Show with Jay Leno, Good Morning America, and more. STOMP made its debut at the Edinburgh Festival in 1991 and met with instant acclaim that led to an Australian tour, quickly followed by performances throughout the world.
