

"The Couch and Cathode Ray Shield Show" on exhibit

"The Couch and Cathode Ray Shield Show," a performance and installation by Daniel Loewenstein, will be on exhibit in the Mandeville Annex Gallery, at the University of California, San Diego from noon to 5 p.m. May 27-30.

The gallery is located in room B-118 of the Mandeville Center. An opening reception and performance will be held at 7:30 p.m. May 26 in the gallery.

Loewenstein, a Master of Fine Arts candidate in the Department of Visual Arts at the university, has created an installation using a couch and television picture tubes which have taken on a variety of functions. The tubes are made out of different materials, including plaster, concrete and papier-mache.

The show is Loewenstein's MFA project.
