

Three UC SIO Staff Members Elected Officers of the American Geophysical Union and Cox

Three members of the staff of the University of California's Scripps Institution of Oceanography have been elected officers of the American Geophysical Union.

They are Robert S. Arthur, Associate Professor of Oceanography, elected Vice President of the Section of Oceanography; Edward D. Goldberg, Professor of Chemistry, elected Vice President of the Section of Volcanology, Geochemistry, and Petrology; and Charles S. Cox, Associate Professor of Oceanography, elected Representative for Oceanography on the Pacific Southwest Regional Committee.

All will take office on July 1, 1961 and serve for three years.
