"Yours Truly," and exhibition of black and white and color photographs containing the image of the photographer, will be on view until March 11, at the Grove Gallery, University of California, San Diego.

The photographers in the exhibition were chosen from a field of entrants made up of UCSD students and alumni, UCSD Craft Center students and alumni, UCSD faculty and staff, and members of the UCSD Retirement Club.

Two purchase awards and two awards of merit were awarded by a jury. Dan Dunne, a UCSD staff member at the Office of Learning Resources, received for his work, "Untitled," a \$100 Purchase Award from the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs Office. The photograph is a photo transfer to fabric. Carol Dubuque, a UCSD Crafts Center photography student, was awarded the University Center's Permanent Collection Purchase Award for \$100, for the photograph "Black and White Thumbs."

The awards of merit from the jurors were given to Caroline Rice, a staff member at the Center for Astrophysics and Space Science, for "Dunes"; and to James Soenyun, for "Self Portrait" (a photo cutout).

The Grove Gallery is open Tuesday through Friday, 10 a.m.-5 p.m., and on Saturday, 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Admission is free. Parking permits are required on the UCSD campus, and may be purchased at the information pavilions on Gilman Drive and Northview Drive. For information call, 534-2021.
