## HOW TO USE END-OF-REEL "TAPE CLIP"







## for shipment of tape reels:

- Squeeze sides of Tape Clip and slide tape under retainer tab on top. Allow several inches of tape to extend beyond Tape Clip, to serve as "puller".
- Slip Tape Clip inside reel and pull down firmly over tape. To remove, shake out free end of tape and pull up.

## for temporary reel storage:

3. Without threading tape under tab, simply turn Tape Clip upside down and press firmly down onto tape inside reel. To remove, lift out or pull out with free end of tape.

IMPORTANT! Remove adhesive end-of-roll tab before using tape.
