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DESIGN PROFESSIONAL WORKSHOP FOR DISADVANTAGED, WOMEN, AND DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED FIRMS AT UCSD

A free design professional workshop for the disadvantaged, women, and disabled veteran-owned firms will be held Sept. 12, from 8 a.m. to noon at the University of California, San Diego.

The workshop, sponsored by UCSD Office of Facilities Design and Construction, will inform attendees of UCSD's affirmative action programs in the selection and contracting of design professionals. Topics include: sole source agreements, agreement dollar values, departmental contacts, design selection and award, subcontractor utilization, UCSD's Design Professional Information and Selection System database, insurance, design professional contracts, agreement support, certification, UC policies and procedures, and affirmative action and law.
