

Chancellor Richard Atkinson issues challenge to undergraduates in Alumni Association's 10K/5K Fun Run Feb. 25

The public is invited to participate in the second annual Joggin' and Jammin' 10K race and 5K fun run/walk to be sponsored by the San Diego Chapter of the UCSD Alumni Association Feb. 25 on the University of California, San Diego, campus.

The activity is a benefit for student scholarships.

A special feature this year is a challenge issued by UCSD Chancellor Richard C. Atkinson to any and all UCSD undergraduates to beat his time in the 10k run. The University leader has offered to contribute \$10 to the UCSD scholarship fund for each student who crosses the finish line before he does.

In addition to that personal reward, runners also are eligible to win a trip for two to an exciting destination and some \$3,000 in prizes. All participants will receive a colorful t-shirt and other free items.

The race starts at 8 a.m. from RIMAC on the north end of the UCSD campus and follows a new course through the campus. Registration begins at 7 a.m. and is \$10 for UCSD students, \$14 for alumni and \$16 for the general public.
