WOMEN IN NEON EXHIBITION OPENS APRIL 29 IN GROVE GALLERY AT UCSD

Women in Neon, a national juried exhibition of neon and light sculpture, will be on view April 29 through May 24 in Grove Gallery at the University of California, San Diego. A reception for the artists will be held from 6 to 9 p.m. May 2. Admission to the reception and to the exhibition is free. The public is invited.

Fifteen artists are represented in what juror Susan Adornato describes as a "glowing example of artistry in alternative media." In addition to Ojai, Wrightwood, Los Angeles, San Pedro, Oceanside, Carlsbad and Cardiff, California, exhibiting artists are from New York, Illinois, Texas, Missouri, Kansas and Washington, D.C.

The artists incorporate neon as a basic element of sculptures made in varying media, including wood, welded steel, plastic, metal screen and a variety of other industrial metals and tubing.

Adornato is the director of project design and development in the Office of Learning Resources, Multi-Media Division, UCSD.

Grove Gallery is located in the UCSD Crafts Center Complex on the Revelle College campus off Eucalyptus Grove Lane. Gallery hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday, and 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Saturday. For information call 534-2021.
