

Biology Dept. chairman Herbert Stern named visiting professor at University of Copenhagen

Dr. Herbert Stern, chairman of the biology department at UCSD, has been appointed a visiting professor at the University of Copenhagen, Denmark for the academic year beginning in September.

Stern, on sabbatical leave for the appointment, will do research and some guest lecturing in the university's Institute of Genetics. The visiting professorship, regarded in academic circles as a distinction, is granted to only one foreign educator each year.

Stern will be accompanied to Copenhagen by his wife, Ruth, and their three children. Mrs. Stern, who holds an M.D. degree, is a practicing pediatrician at Kaiser-Permanente. She plans to study pediatric techniques in Denmark as a clinical observer during their stay in the Danish capital.

The Sterns reside in La Jolla.
