
Dear Mr Malin,

Technical Queries Raised by the Examiner and Needing
the Attention of Mr. Szilard.

The symbol Ph on page 2, line 2 is not understood. If phosphorous is referred to the correct symbol is P.

The word "neutrino" on page 5 is not understood and should be amended or explained.

The Examiner has no knowledge of "triplogen" referred to on page 6. If this substance is known a reference to literature should be furnished to enable it to be identified. If it was not known prior to this invention its method of production should be briefly described.

An explanation of what is meant by the abbreviation "M.E.V." should be inserted on page 5.

The meaning of the word "isomer" as used on page 6 is not clear. If this means "isotope" the latter word should be used, but if it has a different significance this should be briefly explained in the specification.

It is believed that the symbol "Ti" on page 10 may be erroneously used for Thallium Tl. This point should be verified.

The Examiner reports that the discussion of the critical thickness on pages 6 & 7 is not sufficiently clear.

It is stated on page 7 that the density ρ is zero at the surface of an unenclosed sphere of critical thickness. If so, it is not understood how a very large number of particles can emerge from a layer which approaches that thickness, as stated on page 6.

The meaning of the symbol " $n(I)$ " should be explained at page 5, line 10.

The meaning of the word "isomer" as used on page 6 should be briefly defined unless the word means "isotope" in which case that expression should be used.

The Examiner reports that the expressions "efficient processes" and "peculiar radiation" are apparently used in the specification in a special sense, and definition of what is meant should therefore be given.

On page 6 it should be made clear whether all the elements in the list are required in the mixture or only some of them.

The Examiner reports that it is not understood how the value of approximately 100 is obtained from the equation at the foot of page 7. Substitution of the assumed values for E and for "binding" energy of diplogen appear to give a very different figure. The meaning of the abbreviation "M.E.V." should, moreover, be explained.
