

Inauguration of Dr. John S. Galbraith as Chancellor

October 26, 1965

The largest formal academic ceremony ever held on the San Diego campus of the University of California will take Place Friday, November 5. with the inauguration of Dr. John S. Galbraith as Chancellor of the school.

The inaugural convocation is scheduled for 10:30 a.m. in the Building B Plaza of Revelle College on the UCSD campus. Registration of official delegates, expected to attend from the eight other campuses of the University as well as from colleges and universities throughout California, will take place at 9:30 a.m. with the assembling of the academic procession a half hour later.

The inaugural celebration will actually be carried over a four-day period. The events will begin at 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, November 3, with "A Concert by California Artists" honoring Chancellor and Mrs. Galbraith, in the Humanities-Library Auditorium. The program, presented by the UCSD Committee for Arts and Lectures, will include The Schubertians, from the University of California, Santa Barbara Men's Glee Club; soprano Dorothy Westra and tenor Carl Zytowski, also from Santa Barbara; pianist Natalie Limonick from UCLA; and cellist Edgar Lustgarten and violinist Eudice Shapiro, both from Los Angeles.

At 3:00 p.m. Thursday, November 4, the new University Art Gallery, under the direction of University Artist Robert Winsett, will open for the first time with an exhibition of paintings and drawings by Bruce McCracken. The new gallery is located in Building 353 in the Matthews Campus area. The 3:00 p.m. reception, planned in honor of the show, the new gallery and the inauguration, is open to the public.

A full schedule of events is planned for Friday, November 5, beginning at 9:30 a.m. with the registration of official delegates in the Science and Engineering Library in Building B at Revelle College. At 10:00 a.m. the formal academic procession will assemble in room 1329, Bonner Hall, and then proceed to the adjacent Building B Plaza.

The Procession will consist of three parts: the UCSD faculty, followed by the official institutional and learned society delegates and escorts, and, finally, the official party (The University Board of Regents and program participants). The University Marshal, Dr. Denis L. Fox, Professor of Marine Biochemistry, and the Marine Corps color guard will lead the procession. The Marine Corps Recruit Depot Band will perform for the ceremony.

The inaugural convocation will begin at 10:30 a.m. His Excellency, The Most Reverend Charles F. Buddy, Roman Catholic Bishop of San Diego and President of the University of San Diego, will pronounce the invocation and the benediction. Dr. Clark Kerr, President of the University of California, will preside at the ceremony.

Greetings will be given on behalf of the people of the state of California by Lt. Governor Glenn M. Anderson; on behalf of The Regents by Donald H. McLaughlin of San Francisco; on behalf of the San Diego Division of the Academic Senate by Professor Walter Kohn, Division Chairman; on behalf of the UCSD Honorary Alumni by Mr. Charles C. Catlin, President; and on behalf of the Associated Students of UCSD by Mr. Larry Baker, President.

Following the greetings Chancellor Galbraith will deliver inaugural remarks Dr. Fred H. Harrington, President of the University of Wisconsin, will present the main inaugural address. After the address honorary degrees will be

conferred by President Kerr upon Dr. Harrington., who will be sponsored by Dr. Galbraith, and upon Dr. Milton N. Bramlette, Professor of Geology Emeritus at UCSD, who will be sponsored by Dr. Kohn.

A noon luncheon for invited guests will follow the convocation in the new Central Facilities Building at Revelle College. At 2:00 p.m. tours of the UCSD campus will be conducted by student guides. A reception for students with President Kerr and Chancellor Galbraith will be held at 3:00 p.m. in the dormitory area.

The San Diego Division of the Academic Senate will meet with President Kerr at 4:00 p.m. in the Humanities-Library Auditorium.

The inaugural events will draw to a close on a note of gaity at 9:00 p.m. Saturday, November 6, with a ball to be held in the Central Facilities Building, Revelle College.
