On Sunday April 18, 1982 she was driving her car with her husband and husband's cousin when they were stopped by Border Patrol at Nelson's Market, Escondido, Calif. they (BP) blocked her car, keeping her from leaving the market parking lot. She was ordered from car via BP's auto P.A. system, she complied, and BP kept on via P.A. for her to leave auto, thus bringing public attention to the situation, even though she had done as ordered.

She asked BP for what reason was she being detained. She was told that they had no business with her, they were only interested in the two "illegal's" she had in her car. She explained that her husband was born in the U.S. and they continued to loudly call her a liar, the fact that her husband spoke perfect English was the reason that she was allowed to take her husband home. Ms.
