

Two shows open new year at Art Gallery

The Art Gallery at the University of California, San Diego will start the new year with two exhibitions running concurrently Tuesday, January 4 through Thursday, January 20.

Over twenty ceramic sculpture pieces from the art department of the University of California, Davis will comprise one part of the joint exhibition. The pieces vary a great deal - from rather eccentric portraiture to abstract works. Robert Arneson, head of the ceramic division at the Davis campus, is included in the exhibition.

The second part of the joint showing is "Distribution?", a traveling exhibition comprised of pieces by twenty-eight artists dealing with the notion of "distribution." The show was organized by Stephen Zaima of the Museum AvantGarde.

The UCSD Art Gallery, open free to the public, is located on the first floor of the Humanities-Library Building on the Revelle campus. Gallery hours are 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. daily.
