

Dr. Alan M. Schneider accepts appointment as Associate Professor of Aerospace and Mechanical Engineering Sciences

Dr. Alan M. Schneider has accepted appointment as Associate Professor of Aerospace and Mechanical Engineering Sciences at the University of California, San Diego, it has been announced by University President Clark Kerr and San Diego Chancellor John S. Galbraith.

Dr. Schneider's appointment was effective July 1, 1965. He received a degree in electrical engineering from Villanova College in 1945; his M.S. degree in physics from the University of Wisconsin in 1948; and his Sc.D. in instrumentation from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1957.

He has served as an Engineer for Hughes Aircraft Co., General Motors and MIT. Prior to joining the staff at UCSD, Dr. Schneider was Manager, Systems Analysis for RCA, Aerospace Systems in Massachusetts.

He is a member of AIAA and Sigma Xi and is now serving as a reviewer of technical articles on guidance and control for journals published by the AIAA.

Dr. Schneider is the author of several scientific papers. He was awarded the prize for the best paper at the Fifth East Coast Conference on Aeronautical and Navigational Electronics, October, 1958, and received the Samuel M. Burka Award for the outstanding paper on space navigation and guidance appearing in Navigation in 1961-62.
