

Dr. Shepard lecture on "Diving Saucer in the La Jolla Submarine Canyon"

Dr. Francis P. Shepard, Professor of Submarine Geology at the University of California's Scripps Institution of Oceanography, will give a free, public lecture on "Diving Saucer in the La Jolla Submarine Canyon," at 8:00 p.m., Monday, March 30.

The lecture, sponsored by the UCSD Committee for Arts and Lectures, will be presented in 500-seat Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla. No seats will be reserved.

Dr. Shepard, one of the world's authorities on submarine canyons, made three dives in the French diving saucer when it was being used by Scripps last month. He will illustrate his talk with motion pictures in color taken during the course of the dives.

He will be introduced by Dr. Fred B. Phleger, Chairman of the Committee for Arts and Lectures.
