

Oktoberfest celebration sponsored by Campus Recreation

An Oktoberfest celebration featuring a German food fair, beer garden, polka dancing and sports events will take place October 16 and 17 at the University of California, San Diego.

Festivities will begin at 5 p.m. and continue until midnight on Friday, October 16, in Oktoberfest Park, located between Urey Hall and the Recreation Gym. Activities will last from 11 a.m. until midnight on Saturday, October 17, capped by the Grand Polka Ball at 8 p.m.

Admission is free to this event and the public is invited.

Other entertainment planned at the Oktoberfest includes an arts and crafts fair, bocce ball, grass skiing, jugglers and games booths. Souvenirs and Bavarian clothing may be purchased at the concession stands.

Many intramural and intercollegiate sports events will take place during the Oktoberfest. Some of the athletic events scheduled are an indoor floor hockey tournament, men's water polo matches, a women's volleyball match and a 10-kilometer run.

An outdoor recreation swap meet, featuring camping and hiking gear, will begin at noon on Saturday in the Oktoberfest Park.
