THE COMMITTEE ON CHICANO RIGHTS (CCR) ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THEY WILL HOST A CHICANO NATIONAL IMMIGRATION CONFERENCE WHOSE THEME WILL BE A "TIME FOR RESISTANCE" AND A BORDER MEMORIAL MARCH TO CALL FOR THE END OF BORDER BRUTALITIES AND THE MILITARIZING OF THE U.S./MEXICO BORDER ON MAY 23, 24, and 25, 1980 IN SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA.

THE PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE ACCORDING TO CCR SPOKESPERSON HERMAN BACA, "WILL BE TO SEEK SOLUTIONS TO THE ESCALATING VIOLENCE INVOLVING KILLINGS, RAPINGS, BEATINGS AND THE MASSIVE VIOLATIONS OF HUMAN, CIVIL, AND CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS AT THE U.S./MEXICO BORDER AND IN THE CHICANO COMMUNITIES". "FURTHERMORE, THE CONFERENCE WILL ADDRESS ITSELF TO THE FORMULATION OF A "NEW DIRECTION" BASED ON THE SELF-DETERMINATION OF OUR PEOPLE, AND INTO TAKING A UNITED CHICANO POSITION ON THE IMMIGRATION ISSUE BEFORE THE 1980 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION".

THE BORDER MEMORIAL MARCH WHICH IS BEING CALLED ON THE FOLLOWING DAY MAY 25, 1980 AT THE INTERNATIONAL BORDER IN SAN YSIDRO, CALIFORNIA WILL COMMEMORATE THE VICTIMS THAT HAVE BEEN KILLED AND BRUTALIZED BY THE INS/BORDER PATROL.

ENDORSEES, SPEAKERS, WORKSHOPS AND OTHER INFORMATION WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT A FUTURE DATE ACCORDING TO CCR SPOKESPERSONS.

Once again, as has been the history of our people, a NATIONAL CALL for ACTION AND RESISTANCE is being sounded throughout our Barrios, Colonias, and Communities. The issue... Immigration

The time is here for the establishment of a NEW DIRECTION on the Immigration issue. The decade of the 80's call for solutions to the escalating violence and violations of rights which are being carried out against Mexicanos/Chicanos along our borders. The solutions of the past have not worked, Killings, rapings, beatings and the massive denials of our peoples human, civil, and constitutional rights are daily occurring. Appeals to christian attitudes have been ignored, appeals to reason have failed, and appeals to respect the law and the constitution have been denied. The treatment of our people by the INS/Border Patrol through their sweeps in our communities, and the violence being perpetrated by them along the International border gives us a right, and indeed makes it our duty to resist these unjust laws and practices.

What must be made clear is that the treatment of our people through a discriminatory and degrading immigration policy that has consigned Chicanos and Latinos to second class citizenry that are denied equal justice, opportunity, and freedom is a situation that can no longer be tolerated.

THESE are perilous times..... our youth are being called upon to register for the draft for a possible war while their people are being denied the right of first class citizenship and respect of their human dignity. THIS fact makes it clear that La Raza even though it is being called to die for this country is still being treated as a stranger in their homeland.

For the last ten years the Committee On Chicano Rights has rejected and condemned all of the injustices against our people. We believe that the time is now time has come for the definition of a NEW DIRECTION, that the time has come for Chicanos to once again reassert their self-determination and determine what course of action to take; The time has come to design strategy for success, and not accommodation. For that reason we are asking those of you

ONCE AGAIN, AS IN THE PAST HISTORY OF OUR PEOPLE, A CALL FOR ACTION THRU RESISTANCE IS BEING SOUNDED THROUGHOUT OUR BARRIOS, COLONIAS, AND COMMUNITIES. THE ISSUE....IMMIGRATION.

THE DECADE OF THE 1970'S HAS ENDED....BUT NOT THE ESCALATION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST OUR PEOPLE AT THE U.S./MEXICO BORDER, NOR THE MASSIVE VIOLATION OF CIVIL & CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS IN CHICANO/LATINO COMMUNITIES, BY THE INS/BORDER PATROL. THE KILLING & RAPE OF WOMEN (SEE ATT. A), CHILDREN DYING (ATT.B) HANDCUFFED INDIVIDUALS BEING SHOT & KILLED (ATT. C) & INNUMERABLE BEATING ARE OCCURRING DAILY AT THE U.S./MEXICO BORDER. WHILE IN CHICANO/LATINO COMMUNITIES RESIDENTIAL SWEEPS, INVASION OF CHURCHES, & HOMES HAVE BECOME A DAILY OCCURENCE.

AS A RIGHTS ORGANIZATION THE COMMITTEE ON CHICANO RIGHTS FOR THE LAST TEN YEARS HAS ADDRESSED IT SELF TO RESOLVING THOSE ISSUES. OUR ORGANIZATION HAS PETITIONED THE RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITIES, BUT ALL APPEALS TO REASON, MORALITY, LAW & THE CONSTITUTION HAVE FAILED TO REDRESS THE IMMIGRATION ISSUE.
