

Drummond to take part in the Governor's Conference on Youth for Community Service to be held in Long Beach, November 13 and 14

Mr. Kenneth H. Drummond has recently been invited by Governor Edmund G. Brown to take part in the Governor's Conference on Youth for Community Service to be held in Long Beach, November 13 and 14.

Mr. Drummond was recently appointed by Chancellor Herbert York of the University of California, San Diego, as a Community Consultant. Sixty such representatives have now been appointed over the state and will be involved in the Long Beach meeting as well as in the follow-up program.

The Long Beach conference being planned by a group of 33 Young people of high school and college age is aimed at training "teams" of four young people and an adult from the various high school areas of the state. Training will be focused on 37 community service projects now being carried out by young people.

The conference is expected to stimulate local community services by young people in what may well be a local or California version of the Peace Corps idea.
