

"Play of Daniel" to be performed

January 15, 1976

A medieval liturgical drama, the "Play of Daniel," will be presented by UC Davis performers Thursday, Jan. 22, at 8 p.m. in the Mandeville Auditorium, University of California, San Diego. The show is being performed at various UC campuses in conjunction with the UC Intercampus Cultural Exchange by the Departments of Dramatic Art and Music at UC Davis.

The drama, popularized by the New York Pro Musica Ensemble several years ago, will feature the UCD University Early Music Ensemble. Medieval instruments used will include viols, vielles, portative organ, gothic bells and various percussion instruments.

Professor Alan Stambusky, professor of drama at Davis, will narrate English text which amplifies the Latin lyrics. Original dramatics and musical ideas are incorporated in the play, that culminates in the revelation of the nativity scene.

Tickets for the play are \$1.50 for students and \$3 for general admission.
